

Notice of Motor Carrier Limousine Stock Transfer Application for Service in the City of Philadelphia

Permanent or temporary authority to render luxury limousine service as a common carrier in the City of Philadelphia has been filed with the Philadelphia Parking Authority (PPA) Taxicab & Limousine Division (TLD) by the below named applicant. Mr. Stanley Thomson Huntington, Jr. has applied to transfer 50% of the stock of H&S Limousine Service, Inc. (CPC No. 1016200-07) held by Mr. Christopher Spinio. The Protest Fee is \$2500.00 (certified check or MO payable to PPA).
