Driver Certification Training Subjects

Driver training will consist of a minimum of 18 hours of instruction provided for in subsection (a), including the following subjects:

- (1) Authority regulations governing taxicab drivers.
- (2) Authority regulations governing taxicab certificate holders.
- (3) Authority regulations governing equipment.
- (4) Penalties for violation of Authority regulations.
- (5) An overview of the administrative process related to violations.
- (6) The identification and address of the Authority offices responsible for administering the act.
- (7) Customer service issues, including the following:
 - (i) Personal appearance of drivers.
 - (ii) Driver courtesy and hygiene.
 - (iii) Assistance to elderly and people with disabilities.
- (8) Driving and customer safety issues, including the following:
- (i) Defensive driving techniques.
- (ii) Emergency aid.
- (iii) Vehicle and equipment inspections.
- (iv) Crime prevention.
- (v) Accident reporting procedures.
- (9) Issues related to the geography of Philadelphia, including the following:
- (i) Map reading.
- (ii) Overview of major street and traffic patterns.
- (iii) Identification and location of popular landmarks and locations.
