#### **General Description:**

The objective of this position is to supervise the Tow Operators daily to ensure the parking regulations within The City of Philadelphia are upheld while providing a safe and efficient working environment.

### **Principal Duties:**

- Supervise Tow Operators daily to ensure shift runs in a safe and efficient manner
- Assist with daily staffing levels based on workload requirements
- Monitor towing equipment to ensure that it is being used properly for safety purposes and to ensure that the equipment is in good working condition.
- Complete performance evaluations of Tow Operators
- Collection and processing of daily tow statistics and driver logs
- Communicate regularly with various departments to accomplish common goals
- Assist in the development of training procedures to ensure that tasks are completed safely and efficiently
- Assist in the training of new Tow Operators
- Research damage claims to evaluate their validity
- Assist the PPD, PSP, and other city agencies with managing accident scenes on the highway and expressway

- Ability to train Tow Operators on operating smartphone device, DLMS system, and towing policies & procedures
