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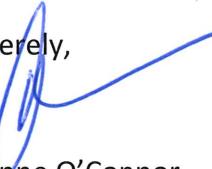
## Executive Summary

Twenty years ago, Philadelphia activated its first red-light cameras along Roosevelt Boulevard. Since then, the program has improved overall driving behavior and helped make neighborhoods safer for commuters and residents alike. Its effectiveness has prompted expansion within the city and into surrounding counties: Bucks County has installed cameras at multiple locations, and Montgomery County has also expanded its program. Continued advances in technology are expected to further strengthen results.

Compared with last year's report, FY2025 citations declined slightly. Approximately two-thirds of monitored locations recorded fewer red-light violations. While violation levels remain higher than in the period before the FY2023 installations, the sustained decline since the warning periods indicates the cameras remain effective. Newer locations installed over the past few years have likewise shown decreases in violations following their warning periods.

Bringing additional camera sites online has been slower than anticipated due to design, permitting, and construction timelines. Lessons learned over the past year should accelerate delivery. In FY2026, the Authority expects to report data for four new intersections, have three more in construction, and submit additional red-light intersection requests to City Council for approval.

## Recommendations

The goal of the Red-Light camera program is to encourage safe driving so that the walking, driving, and riding public can commute without the risk of accidents or fatalities. Currently the program is still considered a pilot program that is set to expire on July 15, 2027. The Authority is hoping that through legislation this program becomes permanent prior to the sunset date. The program has shown success not only in Philadelphia but in surrounding communities in both Montgomery County and Bucks County.

The Philadelphia Parking Authority reiterates the following to better obtain its goal which include:

- Consider increasing the penalty for Red Light Camera violations from \$100 to a base fine of \$150 to further deter violations. The statutory penalty for violations has remained the same since the enactment of Act 123 of 2002. It is believed that increasing the fine will further reduce violations.
- We also wish to further cooperation between the Department of Transportation, the City and the PPA to add additional intersections to the Red-Light Camera Program based upon empirical data developed through a Vehicle Incident Monitoring System (VIMS) study.

## Overview of the Red Light Camera Program

As of the end of FY 2025, the Red-Light Camera Program has thirty-four (34) locations operating with one hundred and forty-six (146) cameras. There are currently no cameras out of service for the fiscal year due to construction. There are seven additional locations approved by City Council that are in various stages of construction. Three intersections are still in design stage, two have completed construction in FY 2026 and two more will be completed by the end of FY 2026.

The Authority also has taken on the cost of intersection upgrades so that the vendor would not be responsible for these costs. Due to the time it takes to have designs made for intersection upgrades, obtaining a Construction Management firm and Electrical contractor through the competitive bidding process, obtaining permits, and the time it takes for construction for the requested upgrades from the Philadelphia Streets Department and PennDOT, the Authority has not been able to complete any intersection installations in FY 2025. The Authority is working through the outstanding requested locations as quickly as possible to continue to assist in reducing traffic crashes, and fatalities throughout the City of Philadelphia and in the process, help achieve our part in the Vizion Zero initiative.

Since last year's report, the PPA has received six additional requests for new red light camera installations. The full list can be found in Appendix A. The Authority has begun doing site reviews of the different intersections with representatives from the Streets Department and PennDOT to find those locations that will benefit from the program. Eight locations were reviewed and those that are viable will be submitted to City Council in FY 2026 for approvals by ordinances. The Authority intends to review more locations as construction continues and will work with the City of Philadelphia's Office of Transportation and Infrastructure Systems (OTIS), Streets Department, and PennDOT to select those that would benefit the most from having a Red Light Camera installed.

In FY 2025, the Red-Light Camera Program has delivered \$25,057,370 to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's Transportation Enhancements Grant Program. This fund provides transportation safety related grants throughout the Commonwealth. Approximately half of those funds are used for safety improvements in the Philadelphia area. In February, PennDOT announced that they were distributing approximately \$20.4 million in Automated Red-Light funding to 25 municipalities statewide. In Philadelphia the ARLE grants will fund the following projects:

- \$1.5 million to continue the Slow Zone program and bring the speed management toolkit to two neighborhoods experiencing high rates of crash-related injuries and deaths. The Indiana project area is in the Fairhill/West Kensington neighborhood in the area of Allegheny Avenue, Front Street, Lehigh Avenue, and Second Street. The Hestonville project area is located in West Philadelphia in the area of Lancaster Avenue, 52nd Street, Girard Ave, and 54th Street.
- \$2 million to continue the "Signal Integration" program and to focus this program on City Avenue, between Presidential Boulevard and 77th Street. which currently runs as adaptive response signal control. With updated signal integration via fiber, the corridor will be retimed and operated via ATMS. Funds may also be used to supplement similar signal integration projects throughout the City.
- \$1.5 million to improve safety for transit users at intersections along SEPTA's Trolley Modernization corridors. Proposed work will improve sight distance, reduce pedestrian crossing time, and allocate additional right-of-way time for transit. This project will be concentrated on

remaining intersections with high crash clusters along Lancaster Avenue from 40th Street to 52nd Street, Woodland Avenue from 50th Street to Cemetery Avenue, and Baltimore Avenue from 54th Street to 61st Street.

- \$2 million to construct modern roundabouts at two or more locations citywide, replace geometrically over-capacity or overly complex signalized intersections having adequate existing right-of-way. The proposed locations are 11th & Wagner Avenue and 10th & Fisher Avenue.
- \$3.6 million for Roosevelt Blvd Parallel Corridor Intersection Modifications. The program will fund design and construction at several locations, which be determined by project viability, crash data, and funding gaps for projects currently underway. Possible corridors for intersection improvements include Castor Ave (from Van Kirk to Cottman) Rising Sun Ave (from Van Kirk to Cottman Ave), and Adams Ave (from Rising Sun to Roosevelt). Other corridors and intersections may be considered in the vicinity of Roosevelt Blvd, depending on need. This project will help to slow traffic at intersections, improve sight distance between drivers and pedestrians, and reduce pedestrian vulnerability by reducing pedestrian crossing times.

The PPA reports annually on the number of violations at each intersection from their inception date to present. To make the report more viewable, we have included the last four years of data from all intersections attached in Appendix B. All prior fiscal year data is available in last year's report which is posted on the Philadelphia Parking Authority's website at philapark.org.

## Intersections and Violations

When comparing FY 2024 and FY 2025, the issuance numbers have declined. There was a decrease of 8.91% in the issuance. In last year's FY 2024's report the dramatic increase in the issuance numbers was attributed to new technology that both vendors installed during FY 2023 as well as possible increased risky driving behavior that has been observed in many different locations.

FY 2025's decrease shows that the cameras continue to influence driving behavior, especially when you look at the locations that are newer. Once installed the numbers start to decrease showing the change in behavior. The PPA remains committed to working with the Streets Department, the Office of Transportation, and Infrastructure Systems (OTIS), and PennDOT by leveraging technology and strategic initiatives to improve road safety and reduce violations to obtain the goals of Vision Zero. Despite the challenges, the program continues to play a vital role in the city's traffic safety efforts, with plans to further expand and enhance its effectiveness in the coming years.

During FY 2025, the Philadelphia Parking Authority released two RFPs looking for a contractor to complete upgrades to new red light camera intersections for safety improvements requested by the City of Philadelphia's Office of Infrastructure, and Sustainability (OTIS), Streets Department, and PennDOT. The selected contractor would also need to coordinate with Elovate for red light camera installation. Carr & Duff was awarded the intersections of N. 20<sup>th</sup> Street and John F. Kennedy (JFK) Boulevard., N. Front Street and Hunting Park Avenue., and Kelly Drive and Eakins Oval. Saravalli was awarded the S. 58<sup>th</sup> Street and Baltimore Avenue project. Construction was completed at N. 20th Street. and JFK Boulevard and N. Front Street. and Hunting Park after the closing of the FY 2025. Construction has started at the other two locations as of the submittal of this report. We hope to be able to provide data for all four locations in next year's report.

There are currently three more intersections approved by City Council and the Secretary of Transportation for Red Light Camera Enforcement. These locations are S. 17<sup>th</sup> Street and Washington Avenue, Kelly Drive and Falls Bridge, and Belmont Avenue and Overbrook Avenue. These are currently waiting for design approval by the City. Once approved, the Authority will go out for Request for Proposal to obtain a contractor to install the requested improvements. These locations will be assigned to Verra Mobility for enforcement.

## Intersections in Progress

Currently there are seven locations that have been approved by City Council. Per the new red light contract the Philadelphia Parking Authority (PPA) is responsible for construction costs associated with the installation of the new intersections. In addition, the PPA has obtained a construction and electrical contractor to complete the necessary upgrades that were requested by the Philadelphia Streets Department and PennDOT. The locations can be broken down into three different phases. They are:

### **Phase 1- Completed Construction after the close of FY 2025.**

- N. 20<sup>th</sup> St. and John F. Kennedy (JFK) Blvd.
- N. Front St. and Hunting Park Ave.

### **Phase 2- Currently under construction and should go live in FY 2026.**

- S. 58<sup>th</sup> St. and Baltimore Ave. (Cobbs Creek)
  - S. 58<sup>th</sup> St. and Baltimore Ave. will take longer to install due to the number of upgrades that have been requested and the age of the infrastructure at this intersection.
- Kelly Dr. and Eakins Oval

### **Phase 3- Working with Construction Management Firm for Planning and Design**

- Ford Rd. and Belmont Ave.
- Kelly Dr. and Falls Bridge
- S. 17<sup>th</sup> St. and Washington Ave.

## Financial Review

Per state statute, the Authority remits all revenue, minus operation expenses to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's Motor License Fund. PennDOT may utilize those funds for a Transportation Enhancement Grants Program (established by section 3116, relating to red light enforcement systems). As discussed earlier in this report, \$20.4 million of revenue that was obtained from all the Red Light Camera programs throughout the Commonwealth were used to fund 31 safety projects all over the state.

## Collection Efforts

The PPA continues to actively collect unpaid Red Light Camera violations. Violators receive two (2) notices the first 30 days after a violation is issued. If the violation is not paid within the first thirty (30) days, additional notices will be sent along with penalties accruing at thirty (30) day intervals to a maximum amount of one hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$175). If a citizen accumulates three (3) Red Light violations or a combination of three (3) total Red Light Camera violations, Speed Camera violations, or parking tickets, the violator's vehicle may become eligible for immobilization.

If a violation is still unpaid after one hundred and eighty (180) days, the violation is forwarded to one of the Debt Collection agencies under contract with the Authority.

For FY 2025 tickets and violations are closed at a rate of 70% within one (1) year, 72% within three (3) years, and 79% within five (5) years. Despite best efforts, there are Red Light violations which are not able to be collected for a number of reasons, such as inability to locate the registered owner, out of state registration, etc. Some unpaid violations have now aged and should be considered uncollectable.

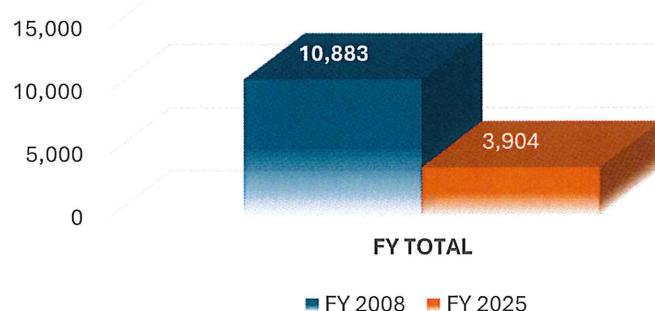
