The Authority intends to engage a single prime contractor for construction of intersection geometry/curbing modifications, drainage updates, traffic signal removal/replacement, pedestrian accommodations, paving and pavement markings to accommodate future installation of Redlight cameras under a separate contract.

Sealed bids will be received until **12:00 PM on Friday, November 22, 2024**, by the Philadelphia Parking Authority ("Authority"), a body corporate and politic created under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in accordance with the Act of June 19, 2001, P.L. 287, No. 22, as amended, known as the "Parking Authority Law," in the offices of the Authority, located at 701 Market Street, Suite 5400, Philadelphia, PA 19106.
