NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Authority intends to engage a single prime contractor to replace existing electrical equipment that is at or nearing the end of its useful life at the Autopark at Fashion District and the Autopark at Old City. Components scheduled for replacement include but are not limited to existing generators, transformers, electrical panels and lighting fixtures.

Sealed bids will be received until **12:00 PM on Thursday, August 8, 2024**, by the Philadelphia Parking Authority (“Authority”), a body corporate and politic created under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in accordance with the Act of June 19, 2001, P.L. 287, No. 22, as amended, known as the “Parking Authority Law,” in the offices of the Authority, located at 701 Market Street, Suite 5400, Philadelphia, PA 19106.
