## **New Driver Certification Application DR-1**

- Please read each question carefully before answering. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- The application fee is **nonrefundable** once the application is submitted and processing begins. If an applicant is requesting a driver certificate for 2 years, the application fee is double the amount as listed on the TLD's current Fee Schedule, which can be located at www.philapark.org/tld.
- All applications must be submitted with a valid U.S. driver license, social security card and a 3<sup>rd</sup> form of identification proving work authorization (for example, for U.S. citizens it is generally a state-issued birth certificate or a U.S. passport and for non-U.S. citizens it is generally a permanent resident card or a work authorization card).
- A check will also be done to ensure that the applicant has no outstanding parking or traffic violations or TLD penalties, fees, etc. unless under appeal. New driver applicants will have until their next renewal (1 year or 2 years) to satisfy all outstanding personal parking or traffic violations.
- If an applicant is eligible to be scheduled for taxicab driver training or limousine driver testing (i.e. the application is complete), the applicant may be issued a provisional taxicab or provisional limousine driver certificate, for up to 90 days from the filing date of the DR-1, or until a certificate is issued by the Authority, whichever is earlier. If the applicant fails to complete the training and/or testing requirements or the application is subsequently denied for any reason, the provisional driver certificate shall be rescinded and surrendered to the TLD. Failure to appear for a scheduled test or training date will result in a \$20.00 fee being assessed for each occurrence.
- All taxicab driver applicants are required to complete training prior to taking the test. Currently, the TLD is the only provider of an approved taxicab driver training program. Therefore, the fee for taxicab driver training is \$100.00, which shall be paid at the time the application is filed.
- False information provided by an applicant for driver certification will result in the denial of the application or cancellation of the driver's certificate if issued prior to discovery of the false information.

RELEASE OF REPORTS: If necessary, the applicant is authorizing the release of the applicant's criminal history report and/or driving record, whether it is a release for the reports from the certificate holder and/or the applicable state agency.

DRIVER LICENSE REQUIREMENTS: Applicants for driver certification must have a driving history in the U.S. of at least 1 continuous year prior to the date of the application. All applicants for driver certification must hold valid U.S. driver license at all times and must not have three moving violations or a major violation in the three-year period prior to the driving history check. A "moving violation" is a violation issued by the Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions for a violation of 75 Pa.C.S. (relating to Vehicle Code), or under a similar statute under any other jurisdiction, that upon conviction of such violation, points are assessed against the driver's license. A "major violation" is a suspension or cancellation of a state-issued driver's license as a result of a moving violation.

CRIMINAL RECORD REQUIREMENTS: An applicant will be ineligible for driver certification if the applicant was convicted of any of the following within the preceding seven years: (I) Driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol; (II) A felony conviction involving theft; (III) A felony conviction for fraud; (IV) A felony conviction for a violation of the act of April 14, 1972 (p.1.233, no.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device And Cosmetic Act; or (V) A felony conviction under 18 Pa.C.S. § 2706 (relating to terroristic threats) or a similar statute in another jurisdiction.

In addition, an applicant will be ineligible for driver certification if the applicant was convicted of any of the following within the preceding 10 years: (I) Use of a motor vehicle to commit a felony; or (II) Burglary or robbery.

Furthermore, an applicant is ineligible for driver certification if the applicant was convicted at any time of any of the following: (I) A sexual offense under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9799.14(c) or (d) (relating to sexual offenses and tier system) or similar offenses under the laws of another jurisdiction or under a former law of this Commonwealth; (II) A crime of violence as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 5702 (relating to definitions); or (III) An act of terror.

PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING FINES, FEES & PENALTIES: Regulated persons and applicants for any right issued by the Authority shall pay all assessments, fees, penalties and other payments due to the Authority on schedule, unless the matter related to the payment is under appeal. Regulated persons and applicants for any right issued by the Authority shall remain current on the payment of parking and traffic violations, unless the violation is under appeal. New driver applicants will have one year to resolve any personal parking or traffic violations or will have two years, if the applicant so chooses to elect and pay for two years of certification.

**TNC DISQUALIFICATION**: An applicant is ineligible for a taxicab or limousine driver certificate if the applicant has been disqualified by the Authority from being a TNC driver under section 53 Pa.C.S. § 57A12(e) (relating to transportation network company drivers) within the 5 years immediately preceding the filing date of DR-1 "Driver Application."

	<b>CERTIFICATION TRAINING AND/OR EXAMINATION</b> : Taxicab driver applicants have the option of being trained by an Authority-approved third party. However, currently there are no Authority-approved third party training programs. Therefore, taxicab driver applicants will have to complete driver training at the TLD, consisting of a minimum of 18 hours in-class instruction over a period of 3 days, for an additional fee of \$100.00, which shall be paid at the time of this DR-1 application filing. The applicant will be tested on the final day of training.
	All new applicants for driver certification will have 3 attempts to pass the applicable driver test conducted by the TLD with a score of 70% or higher within 90 days of the filing of this DR-1 application, or the application will be rendered void. Upon the denial or voiding of the DR-1, an applicant may not reapply for certification for 6 months.
	<b>DRIVER MEDICAL HISTORY</b> : All applicants for driver certification must submit a DR-2 Driver Medical History Form completed by a licensed physician. This requirement will be waived for applicants who possess a current physical exam card issued under the requirements of a commercial driver's license in Pennsylvania. <i>See</i> 49 CFR 391.41—391.49 (relating to physical qualifications and examinations).
	<b>PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE</b> : Upon a <u>completed</u> filing of this DR-1 application (i.e. there are no pending issues and applicant is eligible to attend training and/or testing), the applicant may be issued a provisional driver certificate, for up to 90 days from the filing date of the DR-1, or until a certificate is issued by the Authority, whichever is earlier. <i>See</i> 52 Pa. Code §§ 1021.7 and 1057.8 (relating to taxicab driver training; and certain training subjects).
	However, if this application is subsequently denied for any reason, or if an applicant fails the test after 3 attempts or fails to complete training and/or testing within the 90 day period, the provisional certificate will be automatically rescinded and shall be surrendered to the TLD.
